#### **Pastor's Word**

The word for March is "re-engage".

Re-engage is "to engage in or with someone or something again".

It was a year ago that we had to "shut down" the face-to-face worship, bible studies, and ministry team meetings.

In January (and again February), the United States Supreme Court ruled in favor of the churches in California by maintaining the constitutional right for churches to meet in person for worship (however, they are to follow the state guidelines).

So, we have re-engaged in the practice of in-person worship on the church campus, while still continuing the Sunday morning broadcast of "Worship and Word" on Facebook for those unable to attend.

I want to engage you in praying for me and for those who will help lead in our re-engaging in several areas of the church's ministries. I want you to pray for us to have the wisdom and guidance needed in helping the church move forward.

Let's start with praying for these three areas:

- 1. The **Bible Study ministries** of the church. Studying the Word together in small groups is an important factor in growing spiritually. As we move forward, we want to provide a "safe environment" where we can learn to live in the truth of God's Word.
- 2. The development of the capability to **"Live Stream" the worship service** to Facebook and YouTube. This would include a strategy to develop the relationships we have with those who join us online.
- 3. The development of an **outreach strategy to reach "potentials**" (prospects) and connect them with the gospel and the church.

I realize that this process of re-engagement will take time. So, we need to be patient and alert to see where God is at work and willing to take the steps of faith to join Him.
