Pastor's Word

The word for September is "nearer".

As we enter into September we are nearer to Christmas 2020 than we have been all year. Christmas is less than 112 days away.

I believe we are nearer to reopening the church as well. I have seen the CDC report of August 20, 2020 and have been watching the numbers (the percentages) concerning Covid-19 in Tulare County and there is reason for hope.

I also have been following the court cases challenging the churches constitutional rights to meet and the government's orders restricting the church from meeting (indoors). In California, some churches have been fined thousands of dollars for ignoring the government orders restricting meeting indoors. Some have received threats of further legal actions if they continue to meet indoors from either their city, county, and/or the state governments. I am waiting to see the outcome of the Grace Community Church (Pastor Dr. John MacArthur) case.

As we wait we need to be drawing nearer to God, on our knees, praying for His protection to rest on His church. Asking for His guidance and wisdom as the church navigates through these challenging times. This is the counsel we find in James 4:1-10. Here is a portion of the counsel James gives: (my emphasis in **bold**)

"But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."
⁷ Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. ⁸ Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. ⁹ Lament and mourn and weep! Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. ¹⁰ Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He will lift you up." James 4:6-10 (NKJV)

As we wait on God, we wait in faith, we wait in prayer; submitting ourselves to Him, resisting the devil's temptations, instead choosing to draw near to God, with a repentant heart, confessing our sin, humbled before Him. Waiting for His hand to lift us up for His glory.
